

Covid-19 Safety Measures & Recommendations

First and foremost, while SALL encourages safe practices, we cannot promise a germ-free environment. By participating in and/or attending SALL activities, you assume the risk of possible exposure to Covid-19 and other health conditions. St. Augustine Little League and St. Johns County, including any employees, volunteers, vendors, or other workers, will not be liable for any health issues that may arise from any contact at SALL activities.

- ✔ The bleachers and the area between the bleachers and the area between the bleachers and the dugouts will be designated as an extended dugout for the players, so that social distancing can be maintained by players and coaches while off the field, and, as such, will be prohibited for spectator seating. Parents, families, and other spectators will be asked to sit or stand along the outside of the fenceline from 1st and 3rd bases out toward the outfield fence. Chairs or blankets are encouraged, as seating will not be provided in these areas.
- ✔ All adults, including coaches, are encouraged to wear masks or other face coverings when social distancing is not possible or feasible.
- ✔ Hand sanitizer will be provided to each team in each dugout for use by players and coaches. Players are welcome to bring their own hand sanitizer for their personal use.
- ✔ Players are encouraged to supply their own equipment, such as bats, helmets, and gloves, in order to limit sharing of equipment.
- ✔ After each game, players will not be allowed to cross the field and high-five the opposing team, as is customary. Instead, players will line up on the 1st and 3rd base lines and show some sort of sportsmanship to their opponent, such as applause, "air" high-five, etc. The show of sportsmanship will be decided on by the coaches on a team by team basis.

Please always practice social distancing when possible. We ask that anyone showing ANY signs or symptoms of Covid-19 please remain at home and DO NOT attend any SALL activities.
